1.0 Introduction

The following details the results of data collected from the Rise Adolescent Gambling Prevention (AGP) Sensitization Session conducted at various schools across Jamaica. The results are based on data collected between the months of November 2022 to March 2023 at six hundred and seventy-two (672) schools in Kingston, St. Thomas and St. Catherine.



2.0 Overview: AGP Sensitization Session School Evaluation

- The AGP Sensitization Session was well received by the majority with 62.6% rating it as excellent. (Chart 1)
- This was evident in more than half of students rating 5 out of 7 dimensions probed as 'strongly agree'. The trainer was knowledgeable (73.1%), the quality of the presentation (60.9%), I will be able to apply the knowledge learnt (53.6%), the content was organized and easy to follow (52.5%) and participation and Interaction were encouraged (50.4%) were rated highest as strongly agree. (Chart 2a & b)





- When prompted for suggestions for improvement, 29.5% of respondents noted that they were satisfied and had no suggestions, while majority (67.1%) offered no answer.

 However, it was suggested that more time was needed/ video could be longer. (Chart 3)
- "I would love Mr. Williams to come again", "Thanks for the presentation", "Very Good presentation", "More pink puzzle", "He was good", "It was nice" and "Enjoyed the lesson"" were some of the comments made by participants. (Chart 4)






Chart 2a: AGP Sensitization Session Evaluation






Chart 2b: AGP Sensitization Session Evaluation







Chart 3: Suggestions for Improvement

Almost a third of participants (29.5%) had no suggestions for improvement.


However, the top suggestion made was that more time was needed/ video could be longer (1.6%).
